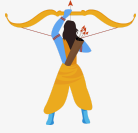

11 October, Friday

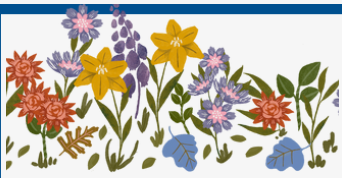


"Through dance, joy flows into life, and through unity, creation is brought forth."

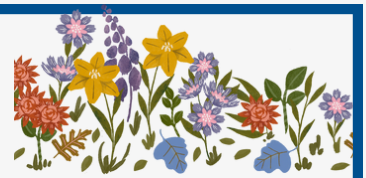
