


















## NATIONAL MILK DAY 26 NOVEMBER, FRIDAY

This hands-on learning experience enhanced their understanding of how the body functions while fostering curiosity and interest in science. It was a valuable and enriching educational activity.










The interactive session captivated their attention and deepened their understanding of nature's wonders, sparking curiosity and enthusiasm for the world of science.
